

# HARFORD ROAD & WORBARROW GARDENS

## DESIGN CONCEPT AND PRINCIPLES FOR IMPROVEMENTS



Small clusters or lines of trees will be planted across both open spaces, adding to the few existing trees, improving the look of entrances and pathways. Some work will be undertaken to existing trees to improve the quality or clear ground vegetation.

An area of wildflower meadow will be created at Worbarrow Gardens, adding to the attractiveness of the open space and providing a fantastic new habitat for birds, bees and other insects.

Small areas for natural play will be created, using logs and boulders to provide a new play experience within the new tree planting, but without taking up too much space.

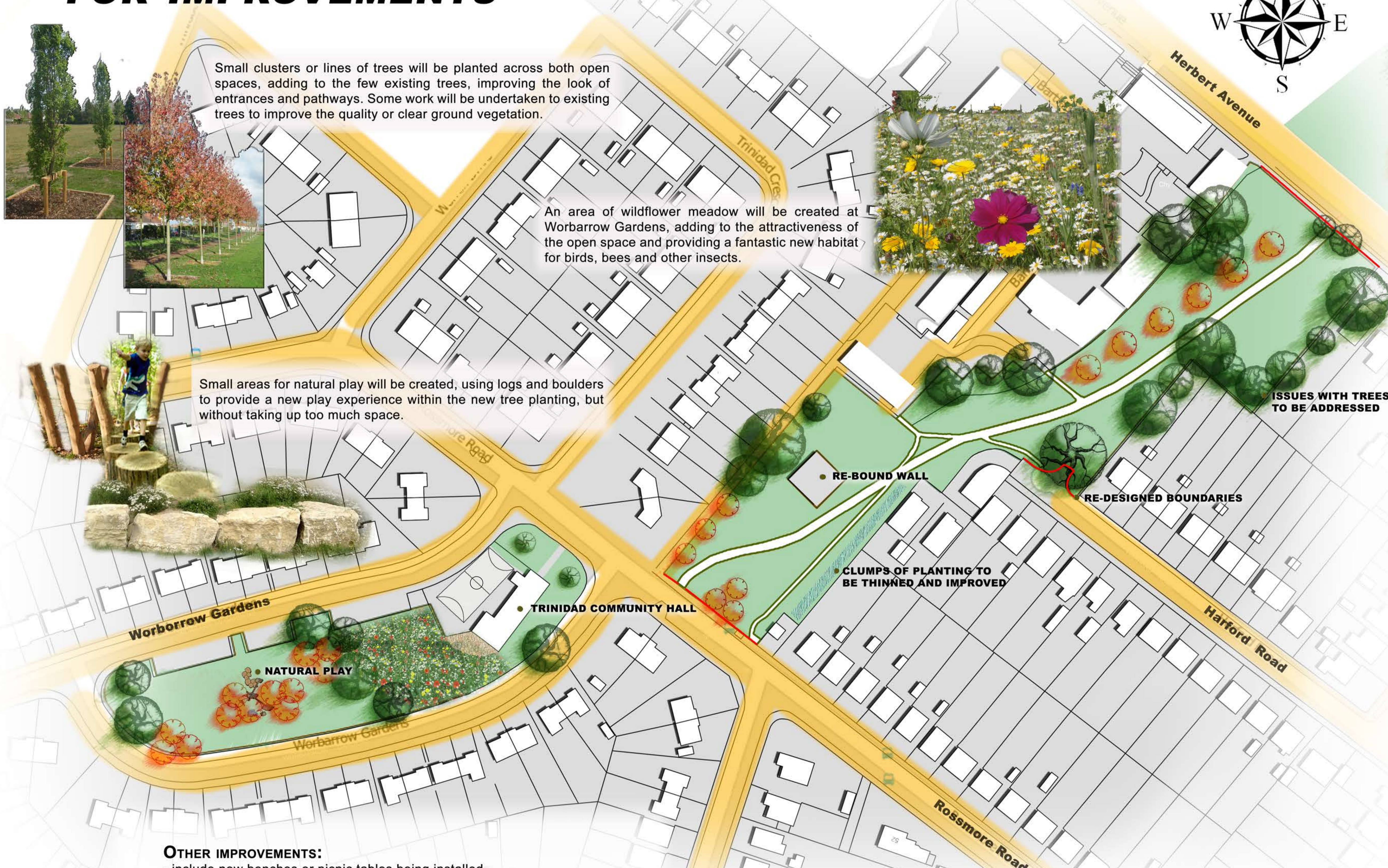
