1. All entries must be submitted with a fully completed entry form by 4.45pm on Friday 20th July at either of the following addresses:

- 2. All submissions need to be sent in published form, ready for display. Maximum size is 1m x 1m and artists are responsible for packing their own work. Completed entry forms must be securely attached to competition entries.
- 3. All competition entries will be on display at the event on 2nd August between 10am and 3pm. Your name will be added to your art piece unless you contact us to let us know otherwise.
- 4. Copywrite of any submission should be held by the entrant and by submitting an entry the entrant is deemed to have authorised its exhibition at the event on the 2nd August 2018. Entrants will also be deemed to have authorised their submissions to be used by Borough of Poole in connection with any event activity or promotion/advertising undertaken relating to the Park. If you do not authorise use for any purpose other than this art exhibition, please make it clear when submitting your entry.
- 5. All competition entries will be available for collection immediately after the event at 3pm. If it is not possible to collect them at this time, please arrange for them to be collected with:

PLEASE NOTE all items must be collected by the 31st August 2018 at the latest. Any items not collected before this date will be disposed of or used at the Borough of Poole's discretion.

6. Prizes will be awarded in all categories. Judging will take place early on the day of the event while entries are being exhibited. Winners of each category will be marked and displayed for the remainder of the event.









- 7. All work entered into this exhibition is done so at the owner's risk. Whilst every reasonable care will be taken when handling all works of art plus volunteer event stewards will be used to monitor the art display during the event itself the organisers of the event will be exempt from liability for all damage or theft that may occur. It is advised that you arrange suitable insurance cover for your own work.
- 8. All artwork should be suitable for a family audience and must be deemed safe by the organisers.
- 9. Organisers have the right to exclude work which does not conform to the exhibition guidelines.
